Willkommen in Frankfurt! Welcome to Frankfurt!

WBA is proud to welcome you to the last stop of the German Masters Series 2016 and to celebrate the German Reunification Day, from 30th of September until 3rd of October in the heart of Germany, in Frankfurt/Main. Frankfurt is the financial hub of Germany with the biggest airport of the country nearby. It's easy to reach bu car, train or plane. The fourth and last stop of the German Masters Series in 2016 will be staged at Holiday Inn Airport North, just a few miles away from the airport. The FRANKFURT OPEN & MASTERS is part of the WBA Circuit 2016. Every match of the OPEN and the MASTERS will count towards the German National Ranking. Additionally, every match of the MASTERS Elite will count towards the WBA Point Race 2016. The FRANKFURT OPEN, is a free entry tournament in a Single Elimination Format. The FRANKFURT MASTERS will be available in 2 divisions and features WBA's computerized T-Swiss System (3 lives + Ultimate Fight). Various side events are lined up (Quarter-entries, DMP-Challenge, Doubles, Mini-Jackpots). Prior to the Main Event, a TEAM CHALLENGE will take place on Friday and Saturday. 10% of the Prize-Pool from the Masters Division will go into the yearly pool, which will be re-distributed at the Grand Finale of the GERMAN MASTERS SERIES. The top 2 players of each stop and the top 8 of the total ranking will qualify for the Grand Finale taking place in Prague in November 2016, prior to the PRAGUE OPEN & MASTERS. Make your travel plans right away, visit Frankfurt, meet your backgammon friends, compete to win the prize-pool, and qualify for the GMS Grand Finale!

Events and Fees:

FRANKFURT OPEN (limited to 64 players, first come, first served): free entry +25 € registration / 5 point matches, Single Elimination, clock preference, First Prize: 500 €

FRANKFURT MASTERS:

Elite Group*: 430 € entry + 70 € registration before 15th Sept. 2016 / optional side-pool 150€ [90% return] / 9 points matches, T-Swiss Format, clock mandatory Leisure Group: 120 € entry + 30 € registration before 15th Sept. 2016 / optional side-pool 50 € [90% return] / 7 points matches, T-Swiss Format, clock optional *: 10% of the Prize-Pool of the Elite Group will go towards the Grand Finale of the GERMAN MASTERS SERIES 2016. Top 2 players of the Elite Group qualify for the Grand Finale.

The usage of official tournament precision dice is mandatory. Clocks are mandatory in Elite Group, Doubles and SpeedGammon matches. Tournament trophies will be presented during the awards ceremony only. Leaving the tournament room without informing the Tournament Director and / or staff might result in penalty points and forfeit. The Tournament Directors reserve the right to change the program during the event. Tournament Director's ruling is final, unless over-ruled by the Ruling Committee.

(based on 30 players, 30-50 players pays 4 prizes, 50+ players pays 5 prizes): Main event based on <30 players: Winner: 40% / 2%: 30% / 3%: 20% / Winner Ultimate Fight: 10%

Main event based on 30-49 players: Winner: 40% / 2^{nd} : 25% / 3^{nd} : 15% / 4^{th} : 10% / Winner Ultimate Fight: 10%

Main event based on 50+ players: Winner: 30% / 2nd: 25% / 3nd: 20% / 4th: 15% / 5th: 10% / No Ultimate Fight
